

**RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PAYNTON NO. 470
FEE BYLAW NO. 01 - 2015**

THE COUNCIL FOR THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF PAYNTON NO. 470 IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. TITLE

1.1 This Bylaw shall be cited as the "Rural Municipality of Paynton No. 470 – Fee Bylaw 01 - 2015"

2. PURPOSE

2.1 The purpose of this Bylaw is to set the amount of the fee that may be charged by the Rural Municipality of Paynton No. 470 for permits, certificates, documents, supplies, and services.

3. FEES

3.1 The following fees shall apply to ratepayers and non-ratepayers:

Tax Certificate	\$ 10.00	per tax card
Tax Statement	\$ 10.00	per tax card
RM Map	\$ 10.00	each plus postage
RM Map Book	\$ 25.00	each plus postage
SAMA Sheet	\$ 10.00	per alternate number
Photocopies	\$.25	per single-sided page
Photocopies	\$.35	per double-sided page
Fax SEND	\$ 1.25	per transmission
Fax RECEIVE	\$.50	per page
Mileage	\$.50	per kilometer
Bulk Water Fees	\$ 1.00	per 64 seconds
Strychnine 2%	actual cost	per bottle
Approach Construction Fee	\$ 50.00	per approach
Approach Widening Fee	\$ 50.00	per approach
Overweight Permit	\$142.86 + 7.14 GST	per vehicle per one-way trip

3.2 The following supplies and services shall be sold to ratepayers only at the following rates:

General PW Labour	\$ 31.00	per hour
Grader w/operator	\$100.00	per hour, minimum 1 hour charge
Tractor w/operator	\$ 75.00	per hour, minimum 1 hour charge
Backhoe w/operator	\$ 81.00	per hour when reg. work hrs (min. 1 hr)
Backhoe w/operator	\$113.00	per hour when o/t hours (min. 1 hr)
Tandem Truck & Sander w/op	\$100.00	per hour PLUS material costs
Truck & Trailer w/op.	\$ 75.00	per hour
Packer	\$250.00	per day

3.3 The following equipment rates shall be charged to Others, Government Agencies and SGI:

Grader	\$100.00	per hour, minimum 1 hour charge
Tractor	\$ 75.00	per hour, minimum 1 hour charge
Backhoe	\$ 81.00	per hour, minimum 1 hour charge
Tandem Truck	\$100.00	per hour, minimum 1 hour charge
Truck & Trailer	\$ 75.00	per hour, minimum 1 hour charge


4. REPEAL

4.1 Bylaw No. 9, 2011, passed February 9, 2011, is hereby repealed.

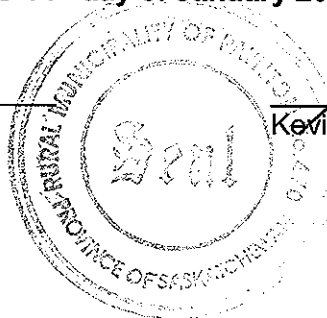
5. FORCE & EFFECT


5.1 This Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the final day of its passing.
