BYLAW NO. 04-2014

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH MILL RATE FACTORS


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Paynton in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows, as per Sec 285 of *The Municipalities Act*:

1. This bylaw shall be known as the "Mill Rate Factor Bylaw".
2. The following mill rate factors shall be applied to the uniform mill rate levied against all taxable property for municipal purposes:


<u>Classification</u>	<u>Factor</u>
a) Agricultural	0.60
b) Residential	1.25
c) Commercial & Industrial	5.40

3. Council has set these rates under the Government mandated Mill Rate Factor limit set at a highest possible ratio of 9, from the lowest to highest Mill Rate Factors.







